line Camp isn't to tough for
it, I will ask for it again.

If line Camp is yertle rough
I will by a service watch and
you and Pa can keep it.

Received some pictures from
June yesterday. They were the
one that were taken just ~~to~~
before I left. She said that
you had a set of them also.

Yesterday afternoon we ran
the obstacle course and
that is all we did all day
long. These last few days I have
really been swell. Nothing to
do but rest.

Got a letter from Russ the
other day. His letter was very
descriptive. Said it was tough
and he was soon going to
see action. Will you send me
his address? I believe I have
lost it. Don't write anymore
until I get my new address
and let you know. Has Pa gotten
any birds yet or can't he hit them.
