Having everything done, am writing you a couple of lines. Got a letter from Mrs. Martinson. Told about Russ and his luck in the Pacific area. Said she had also talked about coming out and seeing life. If you can, come out, but don't if it will put any restrictions on you. It will take about four or five days the way transportation is for. Also got a letter from June, telling of spending the weekend at your house.

We have physical training night now. They track us Judo and all that kind of stuff. Boy, it is really fun. You take some pretty hard falls, but it is swell for a person. It is really fun watching some of the fellows

land pretty hard.

We have to go to a movie every Tuesday night, so therefore I couldn't write any letters. They show some very good battle pictures taking from the islands. I guess I will go to the eight o'clock show this evening. Don't know for sure. Amanuace is going along just fine.

We have a Company inspection Sat. morning. I guess I will have to get every thing in shape. How is everything around there coming? Hope Bob's jaw is better. Suppose it is fairly cool now. There is sure a lot of frustration going around here. Bob thinks very clearly so will close. I'll attempt to make the next one longer and more interesting. Say hello to everyone for me.
