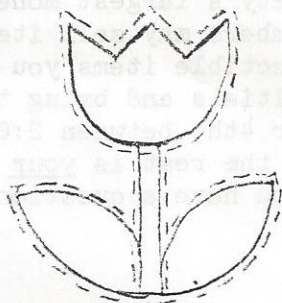
**\*\*HISTORY OF MT. HOREB IN THE MAKING**
