



2025 Scandihoovian Winter Festival
Downtown Troll Town Scavenger Hunt
Mount Horeb, Wisconsin

General walking directions are provided, and all clues are in the order they will be encountered on the walk. This is a circular, clockwise route, starting from and ending at the Driftless Historium (100 S 2nd St), and everything can be seen from the sidewalks.

Remember to be careful when crossing the streets!

Head out the door. Look directly across the street to see the mural covered in flowers.

1. What is the character holding? _____

Turn left and walk down the ramp. Strike a pose for the Photographer Troll!

2. How many toes does he have on each foot? _____

Travel up Second Street. As you near the corner, you are walking along the historic Opera House.

3. The bottom three windows on this side of the building are uniquely shaped. One of them looks different than the others. Why does it look different? _____

Turn left at the corner. Soon, you'll come to a building with lots of blue. This is Gempler's Outlet store. It has three doors.

4. The first door on the left isn't used, and is covered with a shade showing many different workers. What are the bottom three words on the shade? _____

Continue walking west. Cross First and Grove Streets. Remember to stay on the sidewalk, and use the crosswalks. Stop in front of the door of the Mount Horeb Family Pharmacy.

5. You'll find a Pharmacist Troll to greet you. He's holding a mortar and pestle with two letters on it. What color are the letters? _____

Turn right and cross Main Street (heading north), then cross Grove Street to your right (heading east).

6. The Duluth Trading Company store looks like two stores. (It was made from at least two buildings.) Part of the store is brick, and the other part has a wooden-looking facade. How many silver lights run across the top of the brick part of the building? _____

Continue walking east along Main Street.

7. What uplifting structure hides between Sift & Winnow and Thirstea Troll? _____

8. The Hair Loft has a bright green door. What's the number under the mail slot? _____

Continuing east, Isaac's Antiques, Warriors Academy, and Jangle Soapworks are three stores in one building.

9. What is the name of the building? Hint: Look up! _____

The Mount Horeb Municipal Building is on the corner of Main and Second Streets.

10. It is decorated with lots of stone work, including two friezes (sculpted decorations) at the top of the building. What word is written on the frieze closest to Second Street? _____

Cross Second Street [look both ways!] and you'll arrive at a building with four letters proudly telling us the business name (and logo).

11. What two colors are those letters? _____

Keep walking!

12. How long has the business at 214 East Main been selling flowers? _____

Continuing east, cross Third Street and you are in front of the Mount Horeb Area Chamber of Commerce Welcome Center.

13. This inviting building displays U.S. and Norwegian flags and a huge rosemaled "Velkommen" sign. What creatures are found along the top of the building? _____

Turn right and cross Main Street. You are standing just up the street from the Mount Horeb American Legion headquarters (102 S 3rd St), with its insignia on both the building and the porch railing.

14. How many points are on the star in these signs? _____

The Gesme Building is a short walk to the west along Main Street. (Look up to find the right building.)

15. Once you're there, you'll find some words written in lights above the door. What word is written in yellow? _____

Keep walking west.

16. How many steps up to 205 East Main? _____

Turn left, and walk south down Second Street. At the end of the block is the Grumpy Troll Brew Pub. An arrow points up the ramp to the restaurant entrance.

17. What word is written on the arrow? _____

Cross Second Street heading west. Once on the other side of the street, look up and to your left. This building was once a business that sold farm equipment, just like the painted black and white sign says.

18. What farmers' tool is at the bottom of the sign? _____
