- Provide Artist's Statement and portrait.
- Organize and execute related Artist Reception.
- Coordinate design and production of promotional materials (i.e. flyer, postcard mailer/showcard).
- Oversee a related budget of \$250.00**.

*Applicants must be a current MHHS Sophomore, Junior or Senior, or equivalent thereof.

**Funds must be used for expenses associated with art supplies and reception refreshments.

MHAHS will absorb costs associated with printing and postage (an additional estimated investment of \$450.00).
